Canadian Heritage Funding

\$50,070 in Federal Funding for City of Richmond Hill in support of Canada Day Celebrations: Highlighting the ethnic, linguistic, cultural, and regional diversity that makes Richmond Hill an inclusive city.

Canada Community Revitalization Funding

\$209,560 Federal Funding for City of Richmond Hill's David Dunlap Observatory. On May 23rd, on behalf of Minister responsible for the Federal Economic Development Agency for Southern Ontario, Filemona Tassi, I announced a \$209,560 investment for David Dunlop Observatory (RHDDO) under the Canada Community Revitalization Fund for the City of Richmond Hill. More federal funding is underway for the Observatory.


